is the head of the church (Ephesians 5:23) and the one who rules over it. This is important to note because oftentimes, we can take an unhealthy ownership of it. If we are not careful, we start to feel like it belongs to us and think that it should function the way that we want it to. The church, first and foremost, belongs to Jesus.

The second thing that we need to remember is that if the church belongs to Jesus, He gets to tell us how it functions. Over history, we have unfortunately seen how men can take Christ's institution of the church and try to reshape it into what they think it should be or look like. In many ways, we have moved away from what Christ has explicitly said in His Word by twisting it or ignoring it altogether. We have gotten loose with language, licentious in our practices, and created an institution that looks far more like the world than what the Bible says. The argument historically has been that it works, but that kind of pragmatism is not an excuse to ignore and even disobey what the Bible teaches concerning the church.

I share this with you because we are about to journey through 1 Timothy together and will be confronted with what the Bible says pertaining to how the church is to be organized and how it is to function. We all need to have a heart that is willing to submit to Scripture and follow what Jesus has revealed to us. If you and I want to be a part of a healthy, fruitful church, it will only come from doing things God's way. I want to invite you to join me as work through this important book together.
