Go over the memory verses: Luke 17:6, 17:19, 17:20-21. (You may also choose to go over verses from last year if you like.)

Ask someone to read the passage, Luke 17:20-37, or tell the story if they know it.

Ask the group to share their responses to the following:

- How has God spoken to you this week through this passage?
- How does your living show you believe that the kingdom of God is in our midst? (verse 21)
- What do you need to "put in order" to be prepared for the coming of the Lord? What are your plans for doing that?

Ask someone to summarize or retell the passage.
