

September 30, 2018 Huldah the Prophetess

**For the Facilitator** - During the week before the meeting, review the story and the questions. Do an internet search on any issues you might anticipate. Even if you are not telling the story, know it well enough to share. Make sure you are maintaining your own walk with the Lord. Make personal contact with at least one person in your group this week.

**Open in Prayer and Welcome/Introductions**

**Remind the group of DiscipleGroup Guidelines (Confidentiality, Don't Rescue Don't Fix, No Crosstalk, Use Humor Responsibly, Give Everyone a Chance to Share, Use "I" Statements.)**

**DISCIPLEMAKER QUESTIONS**

- Last week we looked at the healing of Naaman. Are there any more thoughts on that story?
- How are your relational investments going?

**Ask a "hook question" to get the group going.**

- Share a time you had to be truthful, knowing how difficult it would be to hear.

**Share background for the story.**

In the reign of King Josiah, a book of the law was found during the repairs on the temple. After Josiah heard the book, he tore his clothes and asked his men to enquire of the Lord about the meaning of this book. This story is about God's reply to Josiah.

**Tell the story with your Bible open on your lap – 2 Kings 22:14-20.** This week's story talks about God's prophetess Huldah, and God's message for Josiah.

**Group members rebuild the story one piece at a time.**

**Read 2 Kings 22:14-20 out loud. Were there any important details left out of the telling or retelling of the story?**

**Discuss these questions:**

1. What do you learn about God in this story?
2. What do you learn about the characters in the story?
3. What stood out to you in this story?
4. Who are the voices of Huldah currently in your personal life or in our church?

**Ask someone to retell the story.**

**Assign next week's passage. Isaiah 6:1-8, The Call of Isaiah.**

**Close in Prayer.**
